Norfolk Clerks – make 2019 your year to commit to CiLCA with Norfolk ALC

There will never be a better year to study for CiLCA – the professional qualification for Local Council Clerks. Bookings are now open for our next CiLCA course, which starts in July. For this year only, eligible Clerks across Norfolk will qualify for a 50% reduction in both our tuition/support fees of £300 and the SLCC registration fees of £350. This will bring the cost down from £650 to £325. Non-members of the Norfolk Association may still qualify for a discount, but please contact us to discuss.

Our CiLCA course is delivered in six sessions, designed to support students as they progress through completion of their portfolio. Next Course dates are: 17 July, 18 September, 16 October, 18 November, 18 December, 15 January 2020. (no session in August). Time and venue: 10 am to 1 pm, Hellesdon.

Our training is provided by Gabbie Joyce, a member of our team and a recognised CiLCA Trainer, who is trained to deliver CiLCA training under the National Training Strategy, using materials developed by the Improvement & Development Board (<https://www.nalc.gov.uk/our-work/improvement-and-development/improvement-and-development-board>)
